





# Progression through four phases







begins with carefully sequenced university input to support observation and practice




includes observation, expert discussion, and opportunities to practise, receive feedback and improve

# The Enquiring Trainee Teacher




Emphasis on learning from observation and expert teachers

# The Beginning Trainee Teacher (SP1)




Emphasis on crafting a lesson and breaking down teaching a lesson into manageable steps

Build confidence in a new school context


Emphasis on planning a sequence of lessons





#### Overview of progression



TPRFs reflect phase expectations



☐ If a trainee meets the phase expectations, they are ready to progress

### Support and challenge

- ☐ If a trainee *does not meet* phase expectations
  - Support and action plan
  - Clear targets within a time-frame
- ☐ If a trainee *exceeds* phase expectations
  - Progress within the phase e.g., to 60%
  - Weekly mentor emails offer suggestions for more challenging targets
  - Liaise with link tutor to agree any further adaptations
